<b>SUBJECT: Temporary Protected Status – El Salvador, Sudan, and Ukraine</b>	

#### Overview:

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is a temporary status provided to nationals of specifically designated countries that are confronting an ongoing armed conflict, environmental disaster, or extraordinary and temporary conditions. The Secretary of Homeland Security has the discretion of deciding when a country's eligibility is designated, extended or discontinued.

#### Details:

The Secretary of Homeland Security has extended TPS for El Salvador, Sudan, and Ukraine. The Federal Register was updated on January 17, 2025.

El Salvador extended through September 9, 2026.

Sudan extended through October 19, 2026.

Ukraine extended through October 19, 2026.

Required documents for processing all TPS nationals for driver licenses or identification cards are located under the Temporary Protected Status (TPS) section of the Acceptable Documents Table (ADT).
