SUBJECT: Temporary Protected Status – Honduras, Nepal and Nicaragua	

Overview:

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is a temporary status provided to nationals of specifically designated countries that are confronting an ongoing conflict, environmental disaster, or extraordinary and temporary conditions. The Secretary of Homeland Security has the discretion of deciding when a country's eligibility is discontinued or extended.

Details:

On July 31, 2025, the United States District Court ordered an injunction of the termination of Temporary Protected Status for Honduras, Nepal and Nicaragua. Until litigation is complete customers are entitled to issuance until **November 18, 2025**.

Customers with a valid EAD card or pending/approved I-821 are auto-extended through November 18, 2025, after which alternative valid lawful presence documents will be required. Those that do not meet the requirements listed in the Acceptable Documents Table (ADT) are not entitled to issuance or a 60-day permit.
