<b>SUBJECT: Temporary Protected Status – Honduras, Nepal and Nicaragua</b>	

#### Overview:

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is a temporary status provided to nationals of specifically designated countries that are confronting an ongoing conflict, environmental disaster, or extraordinary and temporary conditions. The Secretary of Homeland Security has the discretion of deciding when a country's eligibility is discontinued or extended.

#### Details:

On August 20, 2025, the United States Federal Appeals court ruled and overturned the July 31, 2025, court injunction of Temporary Protected Status for Nepal, Honduras and Nicaragua. Litigation is now complete and TPS customers for Nepal are no longer entitled to issuance as of **August 20, 2025**. TPS customers for Honduras and Nicaragua are no longer entitled to issuance after **September 8, 2025**.

Customers will need to provide alternative valid lawful presence documents if applicable. Those that do not meet the requirements listed in the ADT are not entitled to issuance or a 60-day permit.
